SOCIETY'S CHILD-Tempting Fate independent

SOCIETY'S CHILD is a band from California, USA and they present us their debut album here. It contains twelve rock songs with a total time of fifty minutes. The band consists of Mary Letchworth on lead guitar, Steve Langston on bass, Mark Randall on rhythm guitar and Tess Jackson on drums. Steve recently left the band, and at the moment the band is holding auditions for a new bass player. The band was formed in November 1996 and I think their music would be perfect to listen to, while driving on the Route 66. I think that 'rock' would be the best way to describe it. Rock with a lot of feeling and passion. Music that comes from the heart. Songs that would be even suitable for radio airplay in some cases. Although not all of the songs are that strong in my opinion, but hey you can't have it all. For example "Disillusioned" is not my cup of tea, but the average quality of the songs is good. "No Mystery" is a very cool opener, but I also liked "No Time For Love", "Desire" and "Early Morning", which has a great rhythm. I am really curious what the second CD of this band will sound like. The information, that I have here, tells me that there are going to be two cover tracks on this album, whereas "Tempting Fate" contains only self-penned songs. These covers will be "Eleanor Rigby" (THE BEATLES; Who remembers the version of ETHEL THE FROG may raise their hands right now:-)) and "Piece Of My Heart (JANIS JOPLIN; I think that the same hands will appear, when I ask who knows the version of LIONSHEART of this classic rock song:-)).
